The safety of pedestrians, motorists and cyclists on the A37

Increasing concerns have been expressed recently by a number of constituents about various safety issues relating the A37 road, particularly on the section between Temple Cloud and Whitchurch village. For example, the dangers to pedestrians, cyclists and motorists caused by traffic on certain stretches of this road, in villages such as **Temple Cloud, Clutton, Pensford and Whitchurch**, have been highlighted.
